The Tigers East Organization would like to take this opportunity to greet you and invite all Alpine and Tiger owner/enthusiasts to join the club and be a part of all the exciting events and good times that lie ahead. This is the first of a few newsletters that will be free to everyone. However due to lack of time, these letters will not contain all of the features planned for the monthly newsletter.

Tigers East has been formed for the benefit of all Alpine and Tiger owners east of the Mississippi River. We are a non-profit organization whose purpose is to preserve, promote and enjoy our cars.

The club is ready and willing to provide any kind of technical assistance that is needed. Please feel free to contact any of the people whose names are listed in the back of this issue for help. That is why they are there. Tigers East will also provide information on the availability of parts and in the future may set up an inventory of parts for club members. A club member will always have first priority and the best price on any item.

For those of you who like to do more than spectate at a race, Tigers East will be sponcering a racing team - Team Tiger. All members are welcome to join. Team Tiger will provide special assistance to make you tiger roar. We can show 'em whose boss.

Throughout the year Tigers East will coordinate a number of different events in conjunction with your local clubs as well as major events for the whole east coast. These events will consist of things like rallies, autocrosses, gymkhanas, drag races, concourses, conventions, picnics, and more!

MEMBERSHIP

Soon after joining Tigers East, each member will recieve a membership card with an I.D. number on it and a Tigers East embroidered patch. The I.D. numbers will be used for mailing list purposes and may be engraved on members cars and major parts for identification.

Members will also recieve a monthly copy of the Tigers East newsletter containing technical assistance, historical data, pictures of recent events, news of coming events (advertise your event), a classified section, and a hot line on stolen parts. Unlike STOA and CAT, all Tigers East members will be able to vote without being prsent at the elections.

The dues will be \$15.00/yr. for a single membership and \$17.00 a year for a family membership. Family memberships receive two patches and membership cards. Membership forms will be sent in the following newsletter.

Dues will be used only for club purposes; to sponsor events, pay postage, and to build up a club treasury for the needs and ventures of the club. The Tigers East Organization will be run in a professional manner. All funds will be handled by club officers, through a bank account. Finally a yearly audit will be taken and a financial statement will be printed in the newsletter.

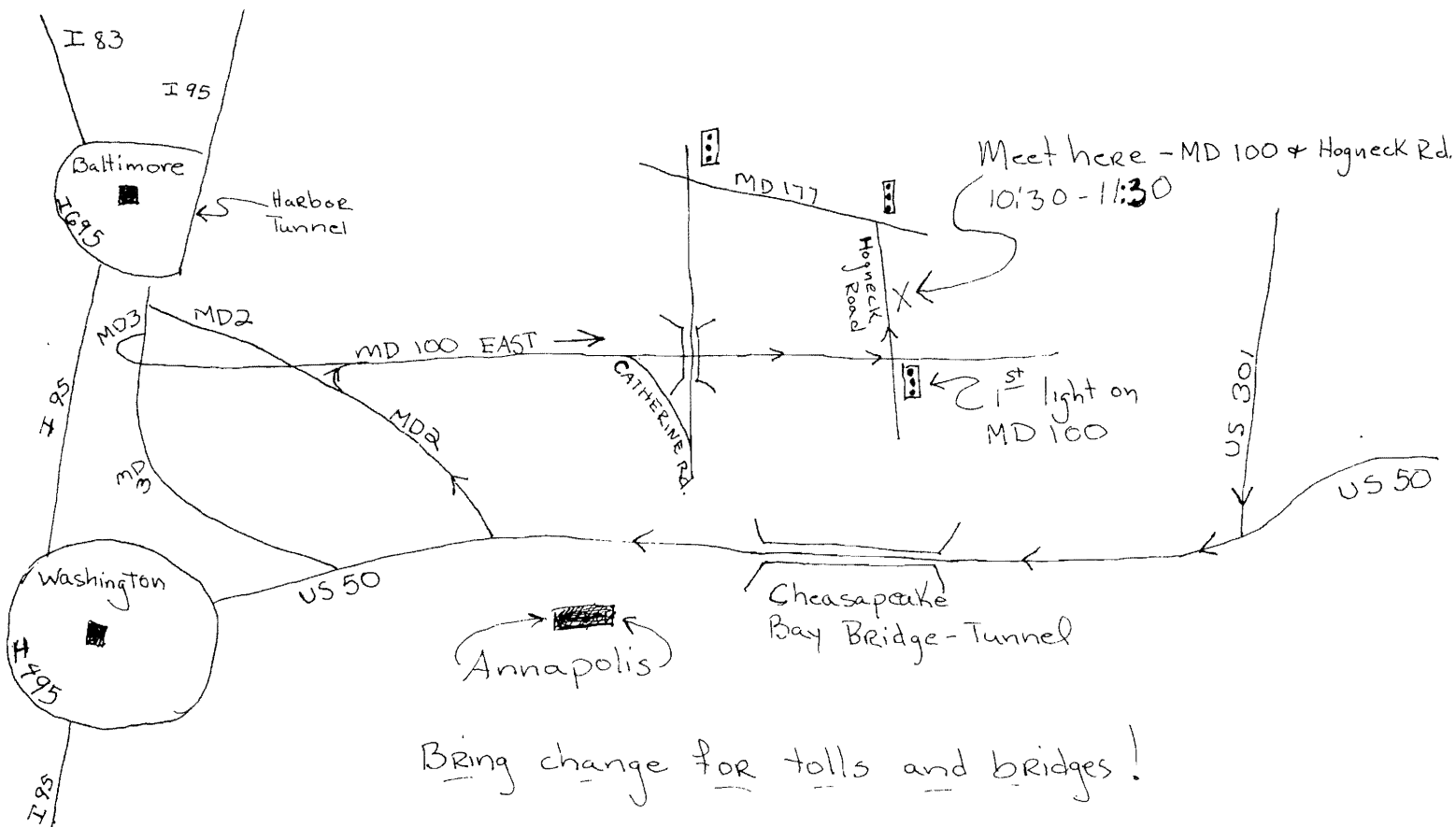
